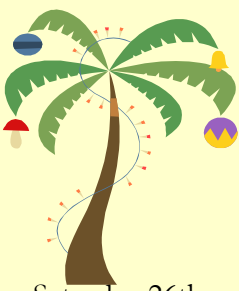
Christmas holiday 2009

Itinerary



- Sunday 20th Arrive to a champagne reception lunch.
- Monday 21st Forest Ride. Get to know your horse while easing yourself into the riding.
- Tuesday 22nd Forest and beach Ride
- Wednesday 23rd Forest and countryside ride
- Christmas Eve Visit to the historic town of Jerez de la Frontera to see the spectacular riding show at the world famous Andalucian School of Equestrian Art
- Christmas Day Start the day with a champagne stirrup cup in the stables and then meander down through sweet smelling pine forest to the beautiful golden sands of the beaches at historic Cape Trafalgar. Enjoy long canters along the shore line splashing through the surf, followed by a fantastic gallop through the shallow waters of the lake that leads to the old thatched tavern of Las Dunas. Here you will stop and relax for a while with refreshing drinks or one of their famous Wobbly chocolates (made with Baileys) before heading back up along forest tracks toward Los Alamos. There will still be plenty of time for more canters through the trees and an amazing gallop along one of the fire breaks. After all that riding you will be probably be ravenous and therefore in the afternoon you will be treated to a traditional Christmas dinner with all the trimmings and of course you don't have to think about cooking or doing the washing up. A succulent vegetarian option is also available along with complementary champagne and other drinks. A perfect day....!
- Saturday 26th Time to ride off the turkey. Follow an ancient Roman road along the cliffs of Barbate with spectacular views across the sea to Morocco, before heading back down to Los Alamos through exhilarating forest tracks and fast fire breaks.
